

**CITY OF HAYDEN LAKE
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 3, 2007**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Prince called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council members present were Jim Riley, Bob Grant and Evelyn Meany by telephone. Councilman Walker was absent. Attorney Pete Bredeson and Dick Pelton were also present. City Clerk Lynn Hagman recorded the minutes of the meeting.

AGENDA

Councilman RILEY moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilwoman MEANY. The motion carried.

Councilman GRANT then moved to approve the consent agenda including the minutes of the March 19, 2007 regular meeting and the unpaid bills for approval. Councilman RILEY seconded the motion. The motion carried.

LAKEVIEW / BOZANTA INTERSECTION

Councilman RILEY moved to ratify the decision of the Mayor to approve the Lakeview/Bozanta intersection improvements by the Hayden Lake Country Club. Councilwoman MEANY seconded the motion. In discussion Councilman Grant voiced his concern that the bicycle traffic may have been overlooked and there is a need to look at a pedestrian walkway through the intersection. Councilman Riley has made Larry Comer aware of this issue and Mr. Comer will be looking into this. **Mayor Prince called for the vote and the motion was carried unanimously.**

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Councilwoman Meany discussed the financial report and stated all was in order. **Councilwoman MEANY moved to approve the February financial report, seconded by Councilman RILEY. The motion carried.**

STREETS

Councilman Riley has requested Chief Johnson to watch the intersection of Lakeview and Bozanta for awhile until people get use to the newly placed medians and to notify the City on any safety issues that may arise.

MCCALL PARK

City Clerk Lynn Hagman reported on the progress of McCall Park. The trusses have been ordered and construction of the restrooms should begin soon. Councilman Riley suggested a sign in the park with the names of the volunteer and those who have donated materials and or labor.

ATTORNEY

Attorney Pete Bredeson gave an update on the Timbercreek subdivision, informing the Mayor and Council that a hearing is scheduled before the County Commissioners.

ADJOURN

With no further business before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
