

**CITY OF HAYDEN LAKE  
REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 17, 2008**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Morris called the regular meeting of the Hayden Lake City Council to order at 4:00 p.m. Present were Council members Bob Grant, Todd Walker and Tom Gorman. Also present as representatives of the Council were Dick Pelton, Larry Comer and Attorney Kevin Holte. Guests present were Andy Emberton and Brian Ogle. Mayor Morris recorded the minutes of this meeting.

AGENDA

Following a review of the agenda, Councilman GORMAN moved to approve the agenda including the minutes of the March 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting and the bills for payment. Councilman WALKER seconded the motion. The motion carried.

IRONMAN

Mr. Emberton discussed his research on the alternate routes through the City for the Ironman Triathlon. One of the routes would isolate the City from coming and going due to closure of roads. Councilman Grant voiced his concern with the weeks of training prior to the race as did Chief Johnson. Mr. Emberton stated that there would be more signs for the routes.

Larry Comer stated that there are two important things for the City to be concerned with. One is safety and the other is legal. Prior to the race, bicycles have the same rules as cars and the City cannot regulate bicycle traffic in the City. There needs to be a means to educate the racers.

Councilman Grant asked if the City will need more man power and if so, who will pay this. Matt stated that the race does not have jurisdiction in town but will try to educate the riders that if two or three ride abreast, the one closest to the center line will be subject to a ticket. This will be put in a newsletter and talks that are given before the race and training.

With no further discussion, Councilman GORMAN moved to adopt Resolution #89 granting the Ironman Triathlon to run through the City of Hayden Lake with a map of the race route attached. Councilman WALKER seconded the motion. There were two ayes and one nay. The motion carried.

## MCCALL PARK

Since McCall Park is open to the public, it was asked if a soccer team could use the field. Council felt this would be fine, however, if any problems occur then it will be stopped. Parking is the main concern.

## MAYOR

Mayor Morris read a letter written to Gerry House, Chairman of the Hayden Lake Recreational Water and Sewer District from Panhandle Health District. The letter asked for a meeting with the Sewer District and the City. Mayor Morris informed the Council that she will speak with Mr. House and set up the meeting with PHD.

## STREETS

Councilman Gorman informed the Council that there would be a meeting with Joe Wuest from Lakes Highway District on Thursday at 9:30 a.m. to discuss the snow removal contract.

## ADJOURN

With no further business before the Council, Councilman GRANT moved to adjourn at 5:23 p.m. Councilman GORMAN seconded the motion. The motion carried.
