

**CITY OF HAYDEN LAKE  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 18, 2014**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Beck called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Council members present were Jim Ackerman, Ed Graves, Tom Gorman and Tommy Frey. Attorney Pete Bredeson and Chief Johnson were present representing the Council. Clerk Hagman recorded the minutes of the meeting. Mr. Steven Woods representing the Church of Later Day Saints was the only visitor.

**AGENDA / MINUTES**

Councilman Gorman moved to approve the agenda including the minutes of March 4, 2014 and the invoices for payment. Councilman Graves seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**VISITOR**

Mr. Steven Woods, 2349 Woodstone Dr., representing the Church of Later Day Saints addressed the Council about projects they are looking for to help the community. Mr. Woods informed the Council that his churches along with other churches are looking for projects where they could volunteer their labor. Mr. Woods suggested a walkway along Strahorn Rd. for easier access to the park. They would be available this fall, late September on Saturday mornings. There are professionals of different backgrounds in the group. Mr. Woods suggested looking at elderly people in our City that may need help with their yards.

Councilman Graves recommends an informal meeting to discuss this. Mayor Beck suggested the clerk place this on the next agenda.

**POLICE REPORT**

Chief Johnson gave the police report for January and February, 2014 and stated there had been a theft and burglary case he had worked on.

**ATTORNEY**

Attorney Bredeson gave an update on the fence variance violation at 10291 Fir Ln. A building permit has been taken out and the fence will be to code.

**CLERK**

Clerk Hagman informed the Council that in looking at the bills from Avondale and checking the meters, a large water leak has been found on Easy St. This issue will be placed on the next agenda for discussion.

**PUBLIC WORKS**

Mayor Beck discussed the reports from Matt Gillis of Welch Comer Engineers regarding Lakeview Dr. and Point Hayden. The heavy rain caused some runoff issue in Pt. Hayden and Dustin Jacobson from the Sewer District dug the ditch deeper and temporarily fixed the problem. Mr. Jacobson will keep an eye on both of these issues when we have heavy rain.

A jail crew will help with cleaning up Mrs. Parden's yard in Pt. Hayden.

Councilman Ackerman asked if Mr. Jacobson could monitor the grate in front of Mr. Walter's residence on Lakeview Dr.
