

**CITY OF HAYDEN LAKE
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 5, 2017**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Beck called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Council members present were Tom Gorman, Tommy Frey and Ed Graves. Councilman Ackerman was absent. Attorney Bredeson and Code Enforcer Mark Durant were present as representatives of the Council. Clerk Hagman recorded the minutes of the meeting. Paul Walker was the only visitor present.

Mayor Beck led the pledge of allegiance

AGENDA/CONSENT AGENDA

Councilman Gorman moved to approve the agenda and the consent agenda including the minutes of August 15, 2017 and the invoices for approval. Councilman Frey seconded the motion. The motion carried.

CITIZEN ISSUES

Mr. Paul Walker, 11185 Avondale Loop, addressed the Council with his concerns of bicycles in McCall Park. Mr. Walker informed the Council of his troubles with kids riding their bicycles on the path and not almost running into people that are walking on the path. The kids have built jumps along the path and it is sometimes difficult to get around them.

Councilman Graves asked what time of day was this happening and what age are the kids. Mr. Walker replied it is sometime after school and they are probably in their teens.

Following a brief discussion of the Council, Mayor Beck directed Attorney Bredeson to draft an ordinance to reflect no motorized vehicles or bicycles are allowed in McCall Park.

SNOW PLOWING

A proposal from Sun Valley Tree Service for snow plowing was presented. Clerk Hagman informed the Council this was the only proposal submitted. Councilman Gorman informed the Council he had some requests from the public to request other bids for the snow plowing. Mayor Beck discussed the possibility of the City buying a plow truck. Clerk Hagman was directed to call for more quotes on the snow plowing and to research the cost of a plow truck.

LEGAL

Attorney Bredeson submitted the renewal agreement for attorney services and stated there were no changes from last year.

Councilman Gorman moved to approve the agreement, seconded by Councilman Frey. A roll call vote was taken; Councilman Graves, "aye", Councilman Gorman, "aye" and Councilman Frey, "aye". The motion was unanimously carried.

POLICE

A written report was submitted to the Council. Mayor Beck reviewed the report with the Council.

CITY CLERK

Clerk Hagman reported on the outstanding building permits and the permits we have paid the State for. Code Enforcer Mark Durant informed the Council there has been one new permit issued and no complaints.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Councilman Gorman suggested the City give a push to the Country Club regarding the pedestrian path around the golf course. Mayor Beck stated he will meet with Eric Shanley on this.

Councilman Frey suggested the City require chickens to be behind a fence with no roosters allowed. The City Code does not allow for chickens in the City.

ADJOURN

With no further business to discuss, at 5:25 p.m. Councilman Frey moved to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Graves. The motion carried.
