Project Status Update

Lift Station Phase A Design, Bidding, and Construction

The first phase of the lift station improvements in the District collection system have been designed and publicly bid. The improvements in Phase A include work at the following lift stations:

- Honeysuckle Beach
- Clark House
- Sandy Cove
- Sherwood Court
- Point Hayden
- Wright's Park

In the process of design, Welch Comer Engineers and the District's Superintendent developed a design to bypass the Canterbury Cove lift station through a series of sewer lines and individual sump pumps. This work began in 2013 in order to work with property owners in the vicinity of these lines. This work will continue in the Phase A project.

The District received bids from three contractors for the Phase A work, and the work was awarded to Road Construction Northwest from Renton, Washington. They have begun work on the lift stations. Sandy Cove is nearing completion; they are working at Clark House and beginning work at Honeysuckle Beach. The remaining stations in Phase A are planned to be complete by this fall.

Lift Station Phase B Work Underway

Welch Comer Engineers has begun work on the second phase of the lift station improvement project (Lift Station Phase B). Phase B will include improvements to Country Club and Avondale lift stations. It will also include the remaining portions of Canterbury Cove work. Welch Comer is currently gathering topographical and rights-of-way information.
